

Starting September 1 in Grande Prairie **CURBSIDE RECYCLING!**

What can I recycle?

Newsprint/Heavy Paper: newspaper, magazines, phone books, catalogues, flyers

Mixed Paper: office paper, junk mail, shredded paper, etc.

Boxboard/Cardboard: cereal boxes, pasta boxes, etc.

Containers: food cans, beverage containers, hard plastics #1-7, deposit items

Large Cardboard: flattened and folded beneath the blue bag - no larger than 2 ft. by 3 ft. (60 cm X 90 cm)

When will my blue bags be collected?

On your collection day. Please have recycling curbside by 7am, a cart width from your garbage cart to the left of the handles, and visible from the road. You can put out as many blue bags as you like – there is no limit! Recyclables in garbage bags, clear bags, or other containers will not be collected.

Clean recyclables and ensure they are dry

What should NOT go in my blue bags?

- × Plastic toys
- × Bubble wrap
- × Plastic bags or plastic film
- × Styrofoam (take to Eco-Centre)
- × Glass of any kind
- × Ceramics
- × Toxic items (batteries, paint cans, aerosol cans)
- × Electronics or small appliances
- × Diapers
- × Scrap metal or wood
- × Food or yard waste
- × Unrinsed or soiled food containers
- × Soiled paper (used tissue or paper towel, pizza boxes smeared with cheese, etc.)
- × Soiled containers



Beginning September 1 Curbside collection should look like this!

All Together Now!

- 1. Recycle** items before they end up in your garbage
- 2. Clean** recyclables and ensure they are dry
- 3. Bag** all items together in a blue bag (no need to separate) with larger pieces of cardboard flattened to be placed under blue bag
- 4. Set** your bag(s) on the curb on your regular collection day –large pieces of cardboard under bags should be no larger than 2 ft. x 3ft. (60cm x 90cm)
- 5. Ensure** your recycling is placed a cart width from your garbage cart to the left of the handles, and visible from the road
