



We're Rolling Out Your Rolling Garbage Cart!

Garbage will be collected in your area using rolling carts. Please read the instructions carefully on how to use your cart.

How to use your rolling garbage cart:

1. Place bagged waste inside the cart.
2. Roll your cart curbside on your regular collection day by 7:00 am and ensure you remove it by the end of the day.
3. Ensure wheels/handles are facing inward toward your home with wheels touching the edge of the street or curb.
4. Be sure there is one metre of clearance on all sides of the cart and overhead – this includes parked cars, fences, and trees beside or above.

What can go in the garbage cart?

Any garbage bags that you would normally place out for collection should be stored in the new garbage cart. Absolutely no hazardous materials.

When will I get a cart?

New garbage carts are being delivered to homes in your area. If you have not received your cart by September 23 please call 780-538-0452.

What is automated collection?

Automated cart collection is a system where a specially designed truck picks up the carts, empties them, and then returns them to their original positions.

When do I start using my garbage cart?

In your neighborhood, you can use your cart immediately after you receive it.

Can I use my existing garbage cart or can?

No, only your new rolling carts are compatible with the automated collection trucks. This is why we have supplied a cart to every household. Your existing carts or cans could be used to separate recyclables.

What if I can't get all my garbage in the cart?

The equivalent of three bags of garbage will fit in the cart – the amount allowed according to city bylaw. If your garbage won't fit in the cart, or your cart is overflowing, it will not be collected. Additional bags can be placed at the curb but must have a bag tag sticker.

Why switch to a cart?

For Residents:

- No more lifting heavy bags or garbage cans
- The carts are difficult for animals to get into, therefore reducing litter
- Aquatera supplies your cart, so you won't need to purchase garbage cans

For Garbage Collectors:

- Reduced injury from lifting heavy bags
- Safer work environment and reduces the handling of dangerous garbage
- More efficient collection system

What happens to the cart when I move?

Rolling carts should remain at your current property, and should not be moved. Each cart has a code which is associated to the residential address to which it was delivered. If you move, empty the cart and leave it at this residence. Ensure it is in a secure location, such as a garage or shed.
