This updated and re-issued Interim Licence particularizes the rights, privileges and obligations embodied in and associated with the original Interim Licence as numbered above, or with any other form of authorization or approval issued in connection with the project identified herein under any former applicable Act or regulation, and updates same to conform to and comply with the current Act, regulations and standards.

In particular this Interim Licence provides for the right to:

A. Construct, maintain and operate works as shown on current plans and reports filed, approved and identified in departmental records as:

B. Divert and use water as hereinafter specified and described subject to the terms and conditions attached hereto and incorporated herein:

PURPOSE: Municipal (urban water supply)

SOURCE OF SUPPLY: Wapiti River

POINT OF DIVERSION: NW 24-70-6-6

GROSS DIVERSION: Up to 5,900 acre-feet* annually consisting of:

1. Estimated Consumptive Use: 1,173 acre-feet

2. Estimated Losses: 7.0 acre-feet

3. Estimated Return Flow: 4,720 acre-feet to Wapiti River

on NW 24-70-6-6

STORAGE CAPACITY: 148.0 acre-feet

RATE OF DIVERSION: 15.4 cubic feet per second

(5,750 gallons per minute)

* 2,000 acre-feet with priority from 1965 02 03 3,900 acre-feet with prirotiy from 1982 08 18

TERMS AND CONDITIONS SUPPLEMENTARY INTERIM LICENCE NO. 12114

1. This supplementary interim licence and any subsequent licence supersedes Interim Licence No. 5614 which was issued on February 25, 1965 and incorporates the rights, priviledges and obligations contained therein.

- 2. The licensee is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the works and for any damages that may result therefrom.
- 3. The licensee shall submit a monthly water use return to the Controller of Water Resources, Alberta Environment not later than 20 days after the end of each month showing:
 - (a) periods and rates of diversion;
 - (b) the daily quantity of water diverted;
 - (c) the total monthly quantity of water diverted;
 - (d) the total monthly quantity of water returned;
 - (e) such other information as may be required from time to time.
- 4. The licensee may enter into an agreement with any person to supply sewage effluent from sewage lagoons for irrigation uses subject to the following provisions:
 - (a) no fresh water shall be diverted directly to the sewage lagoon through the municipal system to accommodate the agreement;
 - (b) each agreement shall be submitted to the Controller of Water Resources for formal approval prior to any diversion of the sewage effluent. Any agreement approved may be subject to future licensing requirements;
 - (c) acquisition of approvals under the Clean Water Act for land application of the sewage effluent; and
 - (d) diversion of the sewage effluent shall be limited to direct diversion from the lagoon itself.
- 5. The Controller of Water Resources may designate a minimum residual flow rate immediately downstream of the point of diversion and the licensee shall be required to cease or reduce any further diversion during periods when the residual flow falls below the rate designated.
- 6. The rights and privileges hereby granted are subject to periodic review and to modification to ensure the most beneficial use of the water in the public interest and more particularly to ensure preservation of the rights of other water users.


TERMS AND CONDITIONS SUPPLEMENTARY INTERIM LICENCE NO. 12114 (Continued)

- 7. The rights and privileges hereby granted can only be extended or modified with the approval of the Controller of Water Resources and are subject to cancellation or modification as provided in the Water Resources Act.
- 8. Following completion of the works herein authorized this interim licence and its terms and conditions shall be attached to and become part of the licence to use water issued under the provisions of Section 33 of the Water Resources Act.
