

2020 - SECTION 93 CURB STOPS IN HARD LANDSCAPING

93.1 GENERAL

Junction boxes are no longer required for the installation of curb stops in hard landscaping.

The work may include the installation of Type-A main valve casing for the protection of curb stops located within hard landscaping (concrete, asphalt, paving stone).

93.2 MATERIALS

93.2.1 Type-A main valve casings or an equivalent approved by Aquatera.

93.3 INSTALLATION

93.3.1 Excavation and backfill shall be in accordance with appropriate section of the Construction Standards of the Municipality having jurisdiction.

In general, backfilling shall take place in accordance with the requirements of Section 88 of the Construction Manual.

The area around the Type-A main valve casing is to be backfilled with select native material, placed in a manner that minimizes settlement and freezing due to excessive voids in the backfill material.

Select native material shall be well graded soil selected by the Contractor from the excavated trench material. It shall have no particles larger than 32mm in its largest dimension. It shall contain no frozen soil, roots, organics or other objectionable material in quantities that might cause damage to the Type-A main valve casing.

The cover of the Type-A main valve casing shall be level to the adjacent driveway surface and grade. The concrete surrounding the Type-A main valve casing shall be shaped to provide a smooth finish without casting the lid in concrete.
