


No increase in curbside collection rates in 2021

On average, we deliver 20 million litres of water per day to customers and return 80% to the Wapiti River

The Eco Centre is the largest recycling depot in the region, recycling items such as paint, electronics, used motor oil, Styrofoam and household hazardous waste





2,745,133 kgs of recycling diverted from Landfill in 2020
