The aforesigned hereby applies for water and wastewater services to the premise described on the application and agrees to pay for such services at the times and <u>rates</u> prescribed in the applicable utility bylaw for the service area:

- The City of Grande Prairie Utility Bylaw C-1365
- The County of Grande Prairie No. 1 Utility Bylaw No. 3160
- The Town of Sexsmith Utility Bylaw No. 1026
- The Town of Wembley Utility Bylaw No. 737

These bylaws regulate and provide for the terms, conditions, rates and charges for the supply and use of the water, wastewater and solid waste utility services provided by Aquatera Utilities Inc.

Aquatera Utilities shall have the right to disconnect, interrupt or reduce utility service at any time without notice, for any of the following reasons:

- a) For making repairs or improvements necessary to facilitate construction, installation, maintenance, repair, replacement, or inspection of any part of the utility services.
- b) To restrict and regulate the use of water for the purpose of conserving water.
- c) To maintain the safety and reliability of the utility services.
- d) Due to any reason, including non-payment of rates and/or charges, emergencies, forced outages, force majeure or potential shortage or interference with the normal delivery of the utility service

## **ANY CONSUMER**

- a) Whose water supply is not metered or
- b) Whose meter is not positioned to the satisfaction of the Manager shall, at the Consumer's expense, arrange for the installation of a new meter or for the meter to be moved.

## **PROTECTION OF METER**

A consumer shall adequately protect the meter on the Consumer's property against freezing, heat and any other internal or external damage failing which such Consumer shall pay Aquatera the cost of repairing or replacing the meter.
